Vigil Honor Nomination Form



Completing this form:

1. Familiarize yourself with the requirements of the Vigil Honor,* being that an Arrowman is:
 - a. a registered member (youth or adult) of Ta Tsu Hwa Lodge;
 - b. a brotherhood member of good standing for at least 2 years as of mid-October, the year of nomination; and
 - c. being recognized for exceptional service, personal effort, and unselfish interest beyond the requirement of their station.

**If you are unsure of whether someone meets all requirements, a nomination should still be submitted. It is better for a nomination to be thrown out than for an arrowman to not receive any nomination.*
2. Write the nominee's full name on the indicated line.
3. Describe why this Arrowman should be considered for the vigil honor.
 - a. Please include sufficient detail. This may be the only material the Vigil Selection Committee has on this Arrowman.
 - b. This can be done in any format (paragraph, bullet point, handwritten, typed, ect.)
 - c. Do not only consider the Arrowman's career in the Order of the Arrow. Their wider service to the Scouting program and to their community are just as important.
 - d. Though a history of the Arrowman's OA career will be provided, detailing important dates, awards received, and positions held, this does not cover any troop, district, or council level awards, events, or positions.
 - e. If more space is required, additional pages may be stapled to this form.
4. Turn this form in at the Indian Nations Council Scout Resource Center or at any Ta Tsu Hwa Lodge event. The Vigil Nomination period ends at dinner on the Saturday of Fall Fellowship, generally held the first weekend of October.
5. Do not let the nominee have knowledge of this nomination, if at all possible. A nomination does not mean immediate selection. If selected, they will be notified by the Vigil Committee at the annual Lodge Banquet.
